

## The service charge: affordability

Owners, in their current property, will be paying for many of the things that at Honeybourne Gate will be covered by the service charge. Owners at Honeybourne Gate will also benefit from savings on care costs compared to buying these services from a home care provider:

### Services included in the service charge:

One band reduction in council tax (F to E Cheltenham)	£6.59

**Total basic weekly saving: £101.89<sup>1</sup>**

**Additional saving on potential care costs:** Assumes 2 hrs per day home support (as recommended by the Government Money Advice Service for budgeting purposes) ie 7days, 2hrs per day, less the 1.5hrs included in the service charge; and based on £19.70 per hr local rate for domiciliary care in Gloucestershire (as reported by the BBC 13.9.16) and proposed rate of £14 per hour at Honeybourne Gate.
